


# Copy Files App



## Purpose

This app allows you to copy files from the project's media folder to another location.

## Source Type

- Predefined List.
- Select this to copy the files in the Files List that you create in this configuration.
- From XML File.
- Select this to copy the files listed in an external XML file.

## New File

- A new file to add to the Files List (3). Type in a new file or use the button to select one.

## Files List

- These are the files that will be copied.

## Add

- Adds the New File to the Files List

## Delete

- Deletes the selected file from the File List.

#### **From XML File**

- This is the location of the XML file if you have selected "From XML File" for the Source Type.

#### **Counter File**

- A file for tracking the files copied.

#### **Destination**

- This is the location for the files to be copied to.

#### **Copy Limit**

- The limit on the number of copies to be carried out.

#### **Limit per session**

- Does the copy limit need to apply to the ACQ

#### **Disk Full**

- The page to be loaded if the disk being copied to is full

#### **Too Many Files**

- The page to be loaded if the copy limit is exceeded.

#### **Write Protected/Error**

- The page to be loaded if the if the copy protection is active.
