

Text Save App



Purpose

This page plugin allows you to enter a range of Acquire variables whose values can be saved to a file or logged to the Acquire log file. Each file or log line contains the values of each variable in CSV (comma separated values) format.

When saved to the log they will be collected by the PLUS! Network Reporting Server and converted into a CSV file. These files can then be downloaded from the Reporting Server website.

Variable values can be logged/saved when the page containing the plugin is entered or exited.

Variables list: These are the names of the Acquire variables whose values will be saved or logged. Each file/log line will contain the values separated by commas, in the order that they appear here (top first).

Use the edit box to enter a variable and then press Add or Change to append it to the list or modify the selected item. Use the other buttons to remove and organize items.

Save variables: Select if the variable values should be saved / logged when the page containing the plugin is entered or exited.

Output to: Select if the variable values should be saved to a disk file or logged to the Acquire log.

File Name: If logging the variable values then this will be the name of the CSV file that the Reporting Server creates. The location is not required so do not enter a file path.

If saving the variable values then this will be the name of the CSV file that the values will be appended to. It should include the full path and file name. The plugin will attempt to create directories if they don't already exist. The filename can be an Acquire variable.
