

# Web Button App

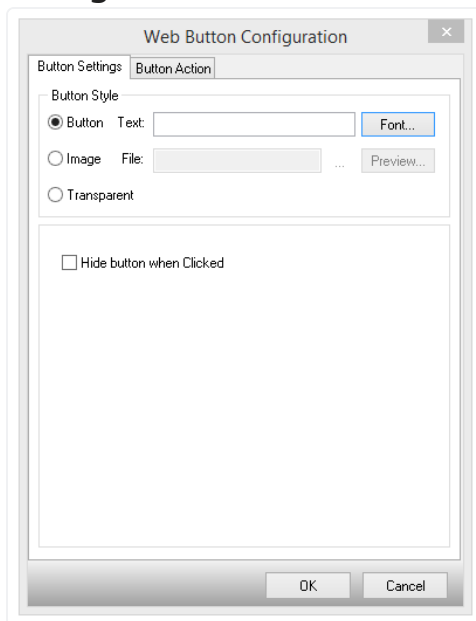


## Purpose

This page app is a button which connects to and controls a ~~Cyber Browser app~~ on the same page. It can be set to perform an action such as Go Back, Home, Stop etc. You can set its text and how it is drawn.

**Note:** If there are multiple apps on the page the Web Button app will only communicate with the first one it finds.

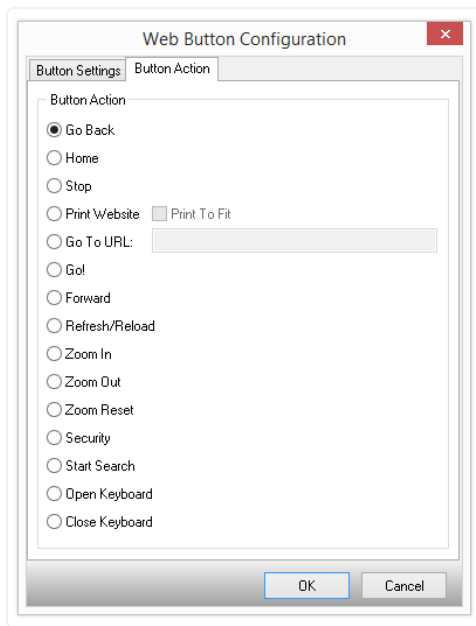
## Configuration



**Button:** Draw as a standard text button. Type in the text to show on the button. Press the Font button to and set its text attributes.

**Image:** Make the button using your own image. Select an image file from the project's media folder. Type in the name or use the "..." button to select one. Use the Preview button to view the image. Text should be included in the graphic.

**Transparent:** Make the button transparent (invisible). This is used where the actual button image is part of the background and you only need to define a clickable area.



## Button Action

Select what action should be performed in the ~~Cyber Browser~~ app when the button is clicked:

**Go Back:** Go to the previous page.

**Home:** Go to your home page.

**Stop:** Stop downloading a page.

**Print Website:** Print the current page.

**Go to URL:** Go to a URL. Specify the URL in the adjacent box..

**Go!:** Go to the URL entered in a WebAddress app that has been placed on the same page.

**Forward:** Go to the next page.

**Refresh/Reload:** Refresh the current webpage.

**Zoom In:** Make the webpage zoom in.

**Zoom Out:** Make the webpage zoom out.

**Zoom Reset:** Resets to the default zoom or zoom-to-fit.

**Security:** The button will appear when navigates to a secure page. Clicking the button will make it show security information about that page.
